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6 **§281.67 Sanctions for Out-of-State Disciplinary Actions**
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8 **(a) When determining the appropriate sanction for a disciplinary action taken by a**
9 **regulatory board of another state under Section 565.001(a)(16), Section 565.002(a)(13), or**
10 **Section 568.003(a)(13), the board has determined that the following shall be applicable**
11 **for all types of licensees and registrants for such licenses and registrations issued by**
12 **the board.**
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14 **(1) If the other state's disciplinary action resulted in the license or registration**
15 **being restricted, suspended, revoked, or surrendered, the appropriate sanction shall be**
16 **the same as the sanction imposed by the other state, such that the licensee or registrant**
17 **has the same restriction against practice in Texas.**
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19 **(2) If the license or registration is subject to any other type of disciplinary**
20 **sanctions, the appropriate sanction shall be equivalent to or less than that imposed by**
21 **the other state unless contrary to board policy.**
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23 **(b) The sanctions imposed by this rule can be used in conjunction with other types of**
24 **disciplinary actions, including administrative penalties, as outlined in this section.**
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26 **(c) When a licensee or registrant has additional violations of the Texas Pharmacy Act, the**
27 **board shall consider imposing additional more severe types of disciplinary sanctions, as**
28 **deemed necessary.**
