6 **§291.6 Pharmacy License Fees**

8 (a) Initial License Fee.
9

10 (1) Prior to October 1, 2015, the fee for an initial license shall be \$500 for the initial registration
11 period and for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacy license as authorized
12 by the Act §554.006. Effective October 1, 2015, the fee for an initial license shall be \$401 for the
13 initial registration period and for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacy
14 license as authorized by the Act §554.006.
15

16 (2) In addition, the following fees shall be collected:
17

18 (A) \$15 surcharge to fund a program to aid impaired pharmacists and pharmacy students as
19 authorized by the Act §564.051;
20

21 (B) prior to October 1, 2015, \$15 surcharge to fund TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter
22 2054, Subchapter I, Government Code; and effective October 1, 2015, \$12 surcharge to fund
23 TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter 2054, Subchapter I, Government Code; [~~and~~]

25 (C) \$5 surcharge to fund the Office of Patient Protection as authorized by Chapter 101,
26 Subchapter G, Occupations Code; and
27

28 **(D) \$21 surcharge to fund the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program as authorized by**
29 **§554.006, Occupations Code, effective October 1, 2015.**
30

31 (b) Biennial License Renewal. The Texas State Board of Pharmacy shall require biennial
32 renewal of all pharmacy licenses provided under the Act §561.002.
33

34 (c) Renewal Fee.
35

36 (1) Prior to October 1, 2015, the fee for biennial renewal of a pharmacy license shall be \$500
37 for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacy license as authorized by the Act
38 §554.006. Effective October 1, 2015, the fee for biennial renewal of a pharmacy license shall be
39 \$401 for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacy license as authorized by the
40 Act §554.006.
41

42 (2) In addition, the following fees shall be collected:

44 (A) \$15 surcharge to fund a program to aid impaired pharmacists and pharmacy students as
45 authorized by the Act §564.051;

47 (B) prior to October 1, 2015, \$15 surcharge to fund TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter
48 2054, Subchapter I, Government Code; and effective October 1, 2015, \$12 surcharge to fund
49 TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter 2054, Subchapter I, Government Code; [~~and~~]

51 (C) \$2 surcharge to fund the Office of Patient Protection as authorized by Chapter 101,
52 Subchapter G, Occupations Code; and

54 (D) \$21 surcharge to fund the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program as authorized by
55 \$554.006, Occupations Code, effective October 1, 2015.

57 (d) Duplicate or Amended Certificates. The fee for issuance of a duplicate [an amended]
58 pharmacy license renewal certificate shall be \$20. The fee for issuance of an amended
59 pharmacy license renewal certificate shall be \$100.

5 **§295.5 Pharmacist License or Renewal Fees**
6

7 (a) Biennial Registration. The Texas State Board of Pharmacy shall require biennial renewal of
8 all pharmacist licenses provided under the Pharmacy Act, §559.002.
9

10 (b) Initial License Fee.

11
12 (1) Prior to October 1, 2015, the fee for the initial license shall be \$281 for a two year
13 registration and for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacist license as
14 authorized by the Act, §554.006. Effective October 1, 2015, the fee for an initial license shall be
15 \$235 for a two year registration and for processing the application and issuance of the
16 pharmacist license as authorized by the Act, §554.006.
17

18 (2) In addition, the following fees shall be collected:

20 (A) \$13 surcharge to fund a program to aid impaired pharmacists and pharmacy students as
21 authorized by the Act, §564.051;
22

23 (B) \$5 surcharge to fund TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter 2054, Subchapter I,
24 Government Code; ~~and~~

26 (C) \$5 surcharge to fund the Office of Patient Protection as authorized by Chapter 101,
27 Subchapter G, and Occupations Code; and

29 **(D) \$21 surcharge to fund the Prescription Monitoring Program as authorized by**
30 **§554.006, Occupations Code, effective October 1, 2015.**
31

32 (3) New pharmacist licenses shall be assigned an expiration date and initial fee shall be
33 prorated based on the assigned expiration date.
34

35 (c) Renewal Fee.

37 (1) Prior to October 1, 2015, the fee for biennial renewal of a pharmacist license shall be \$281
38 for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacist license as authorized by the Act,
39 §554.006. Effective October 1, 2015, the fee for biennial renewal of a pharmacist license shall
40 be \$235 for processing the application and issuance of the pharmacist license as authorized by
41 the Act, §554.006.
42

43 (2) In addition, the following fees shall be collected:

45 (A) \$13 surcharge to fund a program to aid impaired pharmacists and pharmacy students as
46 authorized by the Act, §564.051;
47

48 (B) \$5 surcharge to fund TexasOnline as authorized by Chapter 2054, Subchapter I,
49 Government Code; ~~and~~

51 (C) \$2 surcharge to fund the Office of Patient Protection as authorized by Chapter 101,
52 Subchapter G, Occupations Code; **and**

54 **(D) \$21 surcharge to fund the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program as authorized by**
55 **\$554.006, Occupations Code, effective October 1, 2015.**

56
57 (d) Exemption from fee. The license of a pharmacist who has been licensed by the Texas State
58 Board of Pharmacy for at least 50 years or who is at least 72 years old shall be renewed without
59 payment of a fee provided such pharmacist is not actively practicing pharmacy. The renewal
60 certificate of such pharmacist issued by the board shall reflect an inactive status. A person
61 whose license is renewed pursuant to this subsection may not engage in the active practice of
62 pharmacy without first paying the renewal fee as set out in subsection (b) of this section.

64 (e) Duplicate or Amended Certificates.

65
66 (1) The fee for issuance of an amended pharmacist's license renewal certificate shall be \$20.

67
68 (2) The fee for issuance of an amended license to practice pharmacy (wall certificate) only, or
69 renewal certificate and wall certificate shall be \$35.
