




Executive Directors/Secretaries of the Texas State Board of Pharmacy  
1907 – 2007

In 1907, the 30<sup>th</sup> Legislature created the Texas State Board of Pharmacy and required the five member board to hire a “secretary” with a salary prescribed by the Board. In 1976, the Board voted to change the title to Executive Director/Secretary. Until 1959, the Board’s office was located in the city of residence of the secretary.
