

The Texas Department of Public Safety adopted amendments to Chapter 13, Subchapter D, [§13.75](#), which allows pharmacists to dispense Schedule II prescriptions for 21-days after the date the prescription is issued. Pharmacists are no longer allowed to call a physician and change the date on an official prescription for a Schedule II drug. If an official prescription is presented later than 21 days after issuance, a new prescription is required from the physician. The amendments became effective March 12, 2008.
