

Pharmacist Wall Certificate Replacement

The Board will replace, under certain conditions, a pharmacist's wall certificate (initial certificate). To obtain a **replacement** of the wall certificate, the following procedures should be observed.

If a pharmacist's wall certificate is lost or destroyed, a replacement document may be obtained by submitting the following to the Board office:

- A statement outlining the circumstances under which the document was lost or destroyed;
- The name, address and license number of the pharmacist; and
- A cashier's check or money order, payable to the Board, in the following amount:
\$35.00

If a pharmacist's wall certificate is damaged, the original large wall certificate must be returned along with the replacement request and fee.

Replacement wall certificates will be **mailed via USPS** approximately 4 to 6 months from receipt of a complete request/fee. These certificates are processed in batches, not individually, so time is needed to process this request.
