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## APPLICATION TO PROVIDE REMOTE SERVICES USING AUTOMATED STORAGE AND DELIVERY SYSTEMS

Provider pharmacy-The community pharmacy (Class A) or the institutional pharmacy (Class C) providing the remote pharmacy service.

Automated Storage and Delivery System (ASDS) -A mechanical system that delivers dispensed prescription drugs, which have been previously verified, to patients at a remote delivery site and maintains related transaction information for a provider pharmacy.

Remote delivery site-A location at which remote pharmacy services are provided using an automated storage and delivery system.

- Contract or agreement to occupy the space at which the ASDS will be located (e.g., space contract/memorandum of understanding (MOU), lease agreement, property ownership showing provider pharmacy as the owner of the space, etc.) with a copy of the floor plan where the unit will be located.
- Prior to the issuance of a license for an Automated Storage and Delivery System located in Texas, the board may conduct an on-site inspection of the pharmacy in the presence of the Pharmacist-in-Charge (PIC) and Pharmacy Owner or representative of the Pharmacy Owner, to determine compliance with the regulations in the Texas Pharmacy Act and Board Rules regarding the provision of remote pharmacy services.
