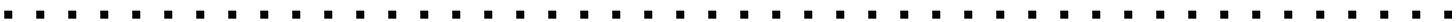

\*\*Optional Holidays A state employee is entitled to observe Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Cesar Chavez Day and Good Friday in lieu of any state holiday where a skeleton crew is required.
