<b>Pharmacists</b>	<b>Yes:</b> Under physicians protocol for patients over 7 years of age may receive influenza vaccine; and patients 14 years of age and older for all other vaccines/immunizations including COVID-19	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacists may order and administer childhood vaccines/immunizations to patients 3-18 years of age	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacists may order and administer COVID-19 vaccines to patients 3 years of age and older	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacists may order and administer seasonal influenza vaccines to patients 19 years of age and older ( <i>not exclusive to PREP Act</i> )	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacists may order and administer tests
<b>Pharmacists-Interns</b>	<b>Yes:</b> Under pharmacist supervision with physicians protocol for patients over 7 years of age may receive influenza vaccine; and patients 14 years of age and older for all other vaccines/immunizations including COVID-19	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacist-interns may administer childhood vaccines/immunizations under pharmacist supervision to patients 3-18 years of age	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacist-interns may order by and under pharmacist supervision administer COVID-19 vaccines to patients 3 years of age and older	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacist-interns may under pharmacist supervision administer seasonal influenza vaccines to patients 19 years of age and older ( <i>not exclusive to PREP Act</i> )	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacist-interns may administer tests under pharmacist supervision
<b>Pharmacy Technicians</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacy technicians may administer childhood vaccines/immunizations under pharmacist supervision to patients 3-18 years of age	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacy technicians may order by and under pharmacist supervision administer COVID-19 vaccines to patients 3 years of age and older	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacy technicians may under pharmacist supervision administer seasonal influenza vaccines to patients 19 years of age and older ( <i>clarified in 8th amendment of PREP Act</i> )	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacy technicians may administer tests under pharmacist supervision
<b>Pharmacy Technician Trainees</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>
<b>Inactive/previously active pharmacists, pharmacist interns, &amp; pharmacy technicians within the last 5 years</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>	<b>Yes:</b> Pharmacists previously active within the last 5 years and currently inactive may administer COVID-19 vaccines	<b>No</b>	<b>No</b>
