

Distribution of Dangerous Drugs and Controlled Substances to Ambulances or EMS Units

A pharmacy may distribute dangerous drugs and if they have a valid (current) DEA registration, controlled substances to the following:

- (1) hospitals;
- (2) pharmacies;
- (3) wholesalers, manufactures;
- (4) practitioners (physicians, podiatrists, veterinaries, dentists, and therapeutic optometrists); and
- (5) emergency medical service providers (EMSP).
