

Reporting a Theft or Significant Loss of Controlled Substances or Dangerous Drugs

A theft or loss of a significant amount of controlled substances and all dosage forms containing nalbuphine (*e.g.*, Nubain®) must be reported ***immediately upon discovery*** of the theft or loss. The following procedures should be followed.

Controlled Substances

- (1) Complete a DEA form 106 as directed and make four (4) copies.
- (2) Distribute the copies as follows:

- One (1) copy — retain in the pharmacy's files for 2 years

**Note: Ambulatory surgical centers must also report any theft or loss of controlled substances to the Texas Department of State Health Services, Health Facility Licensing and Compliance Division, 1100 West 49th Street, Austin, Texas 78756.*

Dangerous Drugs

- (1) Send a letter to the Board regarding the loss of dangerous drugs. Include in the letter the following information:
 - (a) name, address, and TSBP license number of the pharmacy;
 - (b) a list of the name(s) and quantities of dangerous drug(s) lost;
 - (c) a report of the circumstances of the loss; and
 - (d) date of the loss.
- (2) Distribute the copies as follows:
