### ADOPTED RULES

#### CHAPTER 291. PHARMACIES

##### SUBCHAPTER A. ALL CLASSES OF PHARMACIES

###### **§291.12**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted rule §291.12 concerning Delivery of Prescription Drugs. The rule specifies requirements for the delivery of prescription drugs to a patient or patient's agent.

##### SUBCHAPTER G. SERVICES PROVIDED BY PHARMACIES

###### **§291.131**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.131 concerning Pharmacies Compounding Non-Sterile Preparations. The amendments update the personnel, environment, labeling, compounding process, quality assurance, and recordkeeping requirements for pharmacies compounding nonsterile preparations.

##### SUBCHAPTER C. DISCIPLINARY GUIDELINES

###### **§281.69**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy proposed amendments to §281.69 concerning Automatic Denial and Revocation. The amendments, if adopted, correct subparagraph lettering and grammatical errors.
