### ADOPTED RULES

#### CHAPTER 291. PHARMACIES

##### SUBCHAPTER B. COMMUNITY PHARMACY (CLASS A)

###### **§291.33**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.33, concerning Operational Standards. The amendments allow for written information reinforcing patient counseling to be provided electronically unless requested in a hard-copy format and remove the requirement to document the request.

##### SUBCHAPTER F. NON-RESIDENT PHARMACY (CLASS E)

###### **§291.104**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.104, concerning Operational Standards. The amendments allow for written information reinforcing patient counseling to be provided electronically unless requested in a hard-copy format and remove the requirement to document the request.

##### SUBCHAPTER G. SERVICES PROVIDED BY PHARMACIES

###### **§291.133**

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §291.133, concerning Pharmacies Compounding Sterile Preparations. The amendments update the personnel, environment, compounding process, cleaning and disinfecting, beyond-use dating, cleansing and garbing, environmental testing, sterility testing, recall procedure, and recordkeeping requirements for pharmacies compounding sterile preparations.

## CHAPTER 295. PHARMACISTS

### §295.8

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §295.8, concerning Continuing Education Requirements. The amendments establish an electronic continuing education tracking system in accordance with Senate Bill 912, update continuing education programs in preparation for the statutory continuing education tracking system, specify that record retention requirements apply to all required courses, and make grammatical corrections.

## CHAPTER 297. PHARMACY TECHNICIANS AND PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINEES

### §297.8

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted amendments to §297.8, concerning Continuing Education Requirements. The amendments establish an electronic continuing education tracking system in accordance with Senate Bill 912, update continuing education programs in preparation for the statutory continuing education tracking system, specify that record retention requirements apply to all required courses, and make grammatical corrections.

## CHAPTER 291. PHARMACIES

### SUBCHAPTER A. ALL CLASSES OF PHARMACIES

#### §291.13

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy proposed new rule §291.13, concerning Telehealth Services Provided by a Pharmacist. The new rule, if adopted, establishes the documentation and retention requirements regarding a patient's consent to treatment, data collection, and data sharing for telehealth services provided by a pharmacist, in accordance with House Bill 1700.

## RULE REVIEW

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted the review of Chapter 291, Subchapter C (§§291.51 – 291.55), concerning Nuclear Pharmacy (Class B).

The Texas State Board of Pharmacy adopted the review Chapter 309 (§§309.1 – 309.8), concerning Substitution of Drug Products.
